#### **Comments from the Crew serving the WVFPD:**

- Keep grass cut and low around the addresses that are by the street.
- The buckets with sand should be removed. They are in front of some of the hydrants.
- Hydrants could use flags. The flags should be tall and visible from the street.
- The roads are rough in places, and this will slow us down. Of course, weather makes this difficult thus increasing the response time.
- The heavy apparatus still must clear intersections and drive with caution thru the neighborhoods to get to the WVFPD. Dips and bumps take a toll on the engines and trucks as well as other vehicles, but the driver must slow down even more so in the heavy apparatus.
